Opt-In Class Members of
Gallimore v. United States

Dear Opt-in Class Member:

As we previously reported, our motion for entry of judgments was filed and, although the Government did not dispute the calculations, it raised a number of legal issues concerning the Court's power to direct payment of pay accruing after the action was brought and going forward into the future. Despite conferring with counsel for the Government, we could not reach agreement on these issues, as we do not believe they have merit. As a result, the Court has directed that the issues raised be briefed before final entry of judgments.

The Court has directed the Government to file a brief by April 15th, the Class to file a responsive brief by May 9th, and the Government to file a reply by May 24th.

We recognize and share the frustration of further delay, but hope that the Court will dispose of the issues raised in an expeditious manner and one favorable to the Class. We will post the Court's decision as soon as it is received.
