Opt-In Class Members of
Gross v. United States

Dear Opt-in Class Member:

This is an update as of September 24, 2018. We are happy to report we now have the data for all Class Members and all time periods. Hence, we hope to have the final calculations for individual proposed judgments for each Class Member performed by the Class Administrator Rust by early October at the latest.

As indicated previously, once this is done, we will present the calculations to the Government for its review and then submit same as a motion for the entry of judgments to the Court later in October. Again, as has happened so often, we are behind the prior schedule due to matters outside our control, but we are pleased we have gotten much closer to an end.


We will post a copy of the motion on our website (www.altermanboop.com). The motion will have an attached list indicating the name of every Class Member and the judgment amount to which that Class Member is entitled. **We cannot provide this information over the phone or by email.**

Once judgments are entered, the government has two months within which it can appeal. We do not know whether or not it will appeal.

You should also be aware that the Court has asked the parties to report on the status of any settlement negotiations. To date there have been none, but we have reached out to see if the Government wishes to pursue this. We will alert the class once we have an answer.
