

A SETTLEMENT HAS BEEN REACHED IN THE GALLIMORE SUNDAY PAY CASE

The Government has agreed to pay a lump sum to a Settlement Trust to settle the Sunday premium back pay claims of the Class. The amount includes approximately 88.5% of the total amount of back pay which could possibly be awarded with interest through 12/31/20, employer payroll taxes, expenses of the Administrator, and Class Counsel's fees and expenses. Each Class Member will receive a distribution from the Settlement Trust based upon Sunday hours worked. Attorneys' fees and expenses and administration fees approved by the Court will also come from the Trust. No individual will have to pay these separately.

The Court will hold a virtual hearing at the United States Court of Federal Claims, 717 Madison Place, NW, Washington D.C. 20005 at 11:30 am (EST) on May 18, 2021, to determine whether to approve the proposed settlement and set the amount of attorneys' fees and expenses to be paid from the Settlement Trust. Written objections to the proposed settlement will be considered by the Court if received by mail by the Clerk of Court postmarked not less than 15 days prior to the hearing date set forth above (i.e. by May 3rd) with copies sent to Class Counsel and the government. If the Court approves the settlement, the settlement funds will be sent from the United States Treasury to the Administrator, which will then send each Class member their share less taxes, which will be paid directly to the appropriate tax authorities.
